



Information about sponsoring a child

Thank you for your interest in supporting a child via CHILD's Trust. We are supporting nearly 100 children via sponsorship at present, but influence the lives of around 1,000 children in total. We are a small charity helping those in areas of great need; it is hard to imagine people living in today's world without certain basic needs. We are just facilitators so without the help from our sponsors we could not help so many children throughout India. We value any financial support but recognise that without your prayer support we could not achieve as much. Please pray for CHILD's Trust and its work as often as you can.

Sponsoring a child is a commitment, as relationships are built up via letters and pictures. Mark & I visit India at least once per year, to encourage those working so hard with the children, as well as ensuring that your funds are being used wisely. This also gives us an opportunity to up date sponsors on their child.

Children are sponsored until they finish their education but becoming a sponsor does not commit you to any fixed period. You may withdraw from the scheme at any time. You can sponsor a child for just £18 a month.

All correspondence with the children goes via The CHILD's Trust. The letters need to be translated for the children, as well as any reply to you. You will receive the child's original letter as well as the transcript. The older child will be more able to keep in touch with you, but the very young children may start off with just a drawing. We send mail the last weekend of each month, to each of the projects, so birthday cards etc can be sent in good time. Your reply may take a few months, as post out of India is sometimes slow, so please be patient.

If you would like to sponsor a child please complete in the attached forms and return them to us, we will then send you a profile of the child you will be supporting. Once you have this please write an introductory letter, (*please do not write your address on the letter as it could get mis-used*). The children do enjoy receiving letters; also if you have a spare photograph of yourself that would be good. We do not send anything larger as it tends to get taken from the envelopes when in transit. For this reason if you would like to send your child a Christmas or birthday gift it is best to let us know and it can be purchased in India and given from you.
